THE NORMAN AND RITA NUSSBICKEL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Chamber Foundation, Inc. is pleased to announce the availability of the 2010 Norman and Rita Nussbickel Memorial Scholarship. This endowment fund was established in 1987 by the Nussbickel family in memory of Norman F. Nussbickel. The scholarship now honors Norman's late wife, Rita, who passed away in 2006. The Greater Southern Dutchess Chamber of Commerce Chamber Foundation provides additional support to this fund by earmarking a portion of the proceeds from the Chamber's annual Golf Outing held in their honor each June.

The history of the Norman Nussbickel Scholarship Award dates back to the Wappingers Falls Chamber of Commerce – one of the original partners in the Greater Southern Dutchess Chamber of Commerce. Norman Nussbickel served as president of that Chamber for ten years until his death in 1983. It was under Mr. Nussbickel's leadership that the Chamber membership grew from 40 to more than 200 area businesses. And because of Mr. Nussbickel's commitment not only to the Chamber, but to the Dutchess County community, the scholarship was established to honor his legacy by investing in our youth—the leaders and communities of tomorrow.

Rita Nussbickel was a constant presence during Norm's leadership at the Chamber and was a strong supporter of the organization and the community in her own right. She served as Chair of the Scholarship Committee until her death in 2006 and was very committed to the growth of the fund—as it has helped so many students pursue their dreams of a college education. It is an honor to include her name on this important scholarship fund as a living testament to her commitment to community and the students that she so wonderfully supported for many years.

This scholarship enables students in the Wappingers Central, Beacon City and Arlington school districts who have demonstrated leadership qualities in academics, athletics and community to pursue educational opportunities after their four years in high school. Students who have demonstrated extraordinary achievement are selected to interview with the Norman and Rita Nussbickel Memorial Scholarship Committee. Upon final committee decision, the award recipients are announced and presented their scholarship award at a special recognition dinner hosted by the Greater Southern Dutchess Chamber of Commerce. Each of the four award recipients will receive a scholarship in the amount of \$2,000.00 which will be sent to their college.

- An essay describing an event or experience that had a positive influence on who you are as an individual, **or**; discuss an important life experience and what you learned from it. Your essay should be no longer than one page in length.
- Your most recent high school transcript
- Two (2) current letters of recommendation from teachers/guidance counselor, clergy or persons other than family members who are familiar with your skills and abilities.
